1. Camp Information

Theme: Discover 100 WOW ~Girls Can Change the World~

Objectives:

- Empower girls and women to take action to build a better world by contributing to reach SDG5 “Achieve Gender Equality and empower all women and girls”.
- Provide international experience.

Host: Girl Scouts of Japan

Participants: Girl Scout member and non-member girls age from 13 to 18

Number of venue: 7 venues

Number of participants per venue: 100

2. Dates

Term 1: Thursday, 4 August – Monday, 8 August

Term 2: Thursday/National Holiday, 11 August – Monday, 15 August

Term 3: Thursday, 18 August – Monday, 22 August

3. Venues

Term 1: - National Iwatesan Youth Friendship Center (Iwate Prefecture)

- Togakushi Girl Scout Center (Nagano Prefecture)

Term 2: - National Taisetsu Youth Friendship Center (Hokkaido Prefecture)

- National Akagi Youth Friendship Center (Gunma Prefecture)

- National Etajima Youth Friendship Center (Hiroshima Prefecture)

- National Isahaya Youth Outdoor Learning Center (Nagasaki Prefecture)

Term 3: - National Soni Youth Outdoor Learning Center (Nara Prefecture)

4. Number of International Staff per venue: one or two staff

5. Camp Fee: 8500Yen (tentative)

This includes meals and accommodation.

6. Programme

Participants will learn about SDGs, especially on SDG5 at the camp. All programme for 5 days will be planned and provided by Japanese Planning Committee. International Programme Staff will work following the instruction of the Planning Committee and support them.

7. Who can apply for the International Staff

- Women aged 18 or over at the first day of the camp.
- Currently living in Japan with valid visa.

*Girl Scouts of Japan cannot apply any visa for this event staff. Candidate has to have your own valid visa.

- Language at camp: Japanese and English

It is desirable for international programme staff to be able to communicate in Japanese.

- Active Leader of a Girl Guide/Girl Scout organisation of WAGGGS, or used to be a member of Girl Guide/Girl Scout.

*If you are not a current member of a Member Organisation of WAGGGS, you may require to submit a police records check on the application.

- Participate all of pre-meetings and the 5 days camp. The meetings for planning and preparing the camp will be held through online.
- In a good health condition to keep working for preparation and 5 days camp.
- Be able to work delivering programme following instruction of Japanese Planning Committee.
- Communicate well and work with Japanese staff collaboratively.
- Do not mind to sleep in a tent with a sleeping bag for Togakushi venue.

8. Compensation:

All staff for the camp are volunteer.

Girl Scouts of Japan will pay your travel cost to and from venue. The travel cost will be calculated and paid under the travel expense regulation of Girl Scouts of Japan, and not the actual cost.

11. Additional Information

- As a part of programme, we will ask you to introduce the culture of your country/area for participants during the camp.
- We might have a programme to connect with Girl Guides/Girl Scouts of other country/area at camp.
- One or two international programme staff will be accepted per venue. You have to choose the venue on the application form.
- When we have a lot of application for the position, Girl Scouts of Japan will select the staff. The result will be informed by email.
- When we have not enough participants at a venue, the camp could be cancelled. The staff of the cancelled venue will not go to the other venue.
- During the camp, you will stay in a facility and not sleeping in a tent except Togakushi Girl Scout Center. At the facility, you will share a room with some Japanese staff.
