# **Basic Information**

### ■ Objective

The 17<sup>th</sup> Girl Scout International Camp, 2019 has the aim of providing Girl Scouts/Guides and Scouts with opportunities:

- to radiate their youthfulness by participating in a variety of activities which meet their needs
- to foster an appreciation for nature and responsibility for nature conservation through camping in nature
- to enhance world citizenship by interacting with participants who have diverse backgrounds, sharing international friendship and caring each other through camping life

#### ■ Date

August 5(Mon.) ~ 9(Fri.), 2019 (5 days and 4 nights)

#### ■ Venue

Goseong World Jamboree camp site, Gangwon-do, Korea

\* Goseong World Jamboree camp site is the place that the 17<sup>th</sup> World Jamboree in 1991 was held and it is located in the East sea abutting the pacific and has beautiful beaches and world famous-Mt. Guemgang.

#### ■ Camp Emblem



The emblem represents Girl Scout International Camp for Peaceful Reunification of the Korean Peninsula, hoping for peace in the world's only divided nation, and it also shows different friends hugging each other and enjoying themselves as one.

### **■ Expected Participants**

- 4,000 Girl Guides/Girl Scouts and non-member youths
- 3,500 Korean Guides/Girl Scouts, Scouts(age 11~18) and Troop Leaders including non-member youths
- 300 overseas guests from Member Organizations of WAGGGS

- 200 staff members

#### ■ Cost

- The camp fee for 5 days and 4 nights (Aug. 5 Aug. 9): **USD 320**
- It includes: all event program fee, accommodation checking in 5 August and checking out 9 August, meals from dinner on 5 August to breakfast on 9 August, airport transfer on 5 August & 9 Agust, camp souvenirs (T-shirt, scarf, patch, camp handbook and ID card)
- Cost not included: air fares, travel insurance, visa fee, airport transfer before 5 August and after 9 August, personal expense.

- 50% of camp fee is non-refundable by June 20, 2019.
- Camp fee cannot be refunded after from June 21, 2019.

Cooked Korean meals will be served in order for your group to enjoy camping as much as possible and to have some spare time. The specific menu will be informed later. Also we hope your kind understanding that it brings lots of difficulty to meet the dietary need of each camper, because there are about 4,000 campers in the campsite. If you have problem with

Korean food, you are kindly requested to bring some foodstuffs to cook by yourself. The cooking utensil will be provided to you at the HQs of your Sub-Camp upon your prior request.

#### ■ The Preparation of overseas delegation

- 1. International Night
- Preparation for Performance : national costumes, digital music file, any materials needed for your performance
- 2. International Exhibition
  - Preparation for Exhibition : all materials needed to show your own country and association
- \*\*International Exhibition: This will be arranged during the whole camp period, and 2~3 countries will be assigned in a tent (5m x 5m). GSK will provide 1 or 2 table(s) (1.8m x 0.9m) for each country with prior request.

\*International Program: It is highly appreciated if you can introduce some programs that represent culture and tradition of your country such as song, game, dance and so on at the exhibition booth.

#### **■** Weather

Summer in Korea is hot and humid with an average temperature of  $23^{\circ}\text{C}(73\,\text{F}) \sim 33^{\circ}\text{C}(91\,\text{F})$ . It will be sunny with occasional rain showers. It may be cool at night and warm clothes are to be prepared.

#### ■ Other Information

- The overseas delegation with large number of participants may be assigned to the different Sub-Camps which are managed by the City/Provincial Councils of the Girl Scouts of Korea.
- 1 troop leader per 9 girls is highly recommended.
- Each delegation is responsible for its own insurance. Each participant has to pay for all costs caused by medical treatment and hospital stays. The delegation is advised to consider travel or international health insurance.
